## The Basics

### Grammar Focus: Study the contractions of the verb 'to be'.

I am → I'm

You are → You're

He is → He's

She is → She's

We are → We're

They are → They're

Now, try making sentences with all of the contractions.

### Grammar Focus II: Study the negative contractions of the verb 'to be'.

I am not → I'm not

You are not → You're not / You aren't

He is not → He's not / He isn't

She is not → She's not / She isn't

We are not → We're not / We aren't

They are not → They're not / They aren't

Now, try making sentences with all of the contractions.

### Grammar Focus III: Study the question forms of the verb 'to be'.

I am → Am I...?

You are → Are you...?

He is → Is he...?

She is → Is she...?

We are → Are we...?

They are → Are they...?

### Speaking Element: Think of a famous person and follow the instructions.

Think of a famous person that everyone will know. Now, imagine you are that famous person!

Your classmates will ask you questions. You will only be able to answer 'yes' or 'no' to the questions.

Example questions could be: Are you Spanish? Are you an actor?

See how many questions your classmates need to guess who you are!
