Preparation

- 5-15 minutes
- Print one resource for each student.
- If you wish to play the memory game or bingo, you will need to print and cut out the cards beforehand.

Exercise Summary

Resource: an A4 sheet with the alphabet printed in capital and small letters

Memory Game: alphabet cards to be printed twice, cut out, and placed face down on the table

Bingo: bingo cards to be cut out and distributed to students

Resource:

This is a basic resource with the alphabet printed in capital and small letters. Please use this resource as you require. *Students whose first language does not use the Latin alphabet will need extra time and help here.

Memory Game:

This is a copy of the instructions offered on the Memory Game worksheet.

- 1. Print out two copies of the Memory Game worksheet.
- 2. Cut along the black lines to make alphabet cards. You should have two of each letter.
- 3. Mix the cards together and then lay them out on the table.
- 4. Get the students to pick two cards. Turn them over to reveal them.
- 5. If students find a match, they win the cards. If the cards are different, turn them back over.
- 6. Repeat steps 4 and 5 until there are no cards left.
- 7. The winner is the student or team with the most cards at the end of the game.

Bingo Cards:

This is a copy of the instructions offered on the Memory Game worksheet.

- Each student must have a bingo card.
 - o You can print and cut out the bingo cards below or ask students to make them.
 - o If students make their own, they must not repeat any letters on their card.
- Call out letters from the alphabet, one at a time.
- If a student has the letter on their card, they can cross it out.
- The first student to cross out a line of four (horizontal, vertical, or diagonal) shouts "Line!".
- The first student to cross out all the letters on their card and shout "Bingo!" wins.
